Avoid use of unit near or in contact of power lines or live electrical sources.

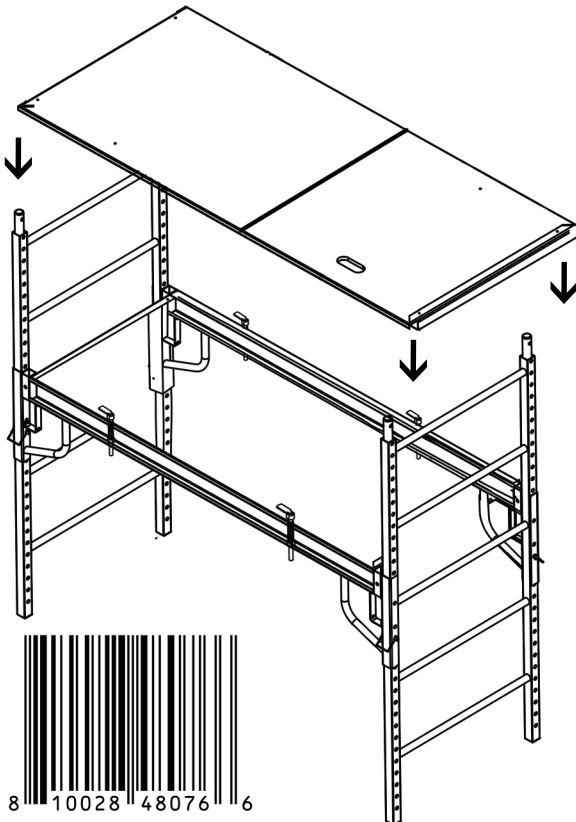


Weight Capacity

This Unit was designed for a maximum capacity load of 1,111 LBS (504 kg). Weight Capacity DECREASES with stacking. Only use Scaffoldmart outriggers and stacking units.

- Never over extend when opening hatch.
- Hatch strap is designed to not stay open for safety reasons.
- Do not force hatch to stay open.
- Make sure hatch is firmly down and the latch is engaged before stepping on hatch. Failure to do so could break latch or cause injury.

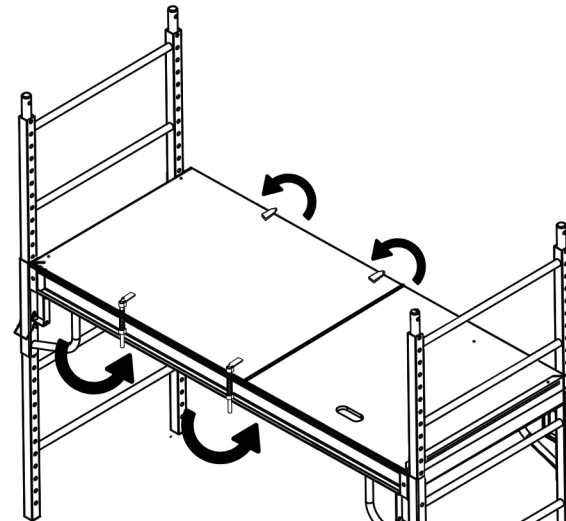
1 Remove from box and inspect for damage before every use. Do not use a bent or damaged walkboard.



2 Place walkboard in side rail grooves. Confirm it is firmly seated all the way down on each side.

3 Install spring latch and firmly secure both sides of walkboard to multifunction unit.

4 Secure hatch latch before walking on walkboard.
